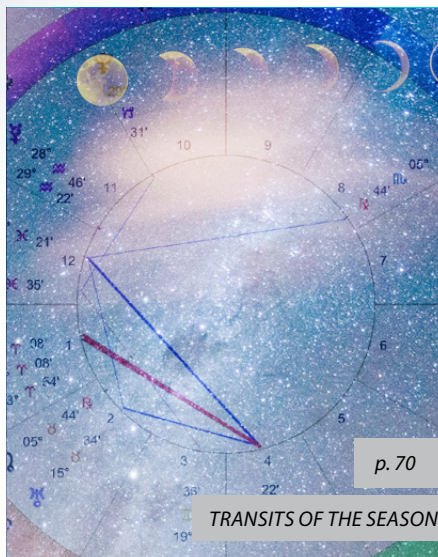

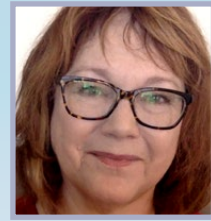

ON THE PRECIPICE OF CHANGE

2023, THE YEAR AHEAD

2023 is set to be an intense transformational time for all. Pluto entering Aquarius is the driving force. All other planetary movements are linked to this and will fill in the details. We will see marked changes in attitudes to financial structures and wealth. This will be the year when we awaken from our wishful thinking of returning to an old "normal."

As big as the Pluto Cycle is, it sits inside an even larger one of the great conjunction between Pluto and Neptune.

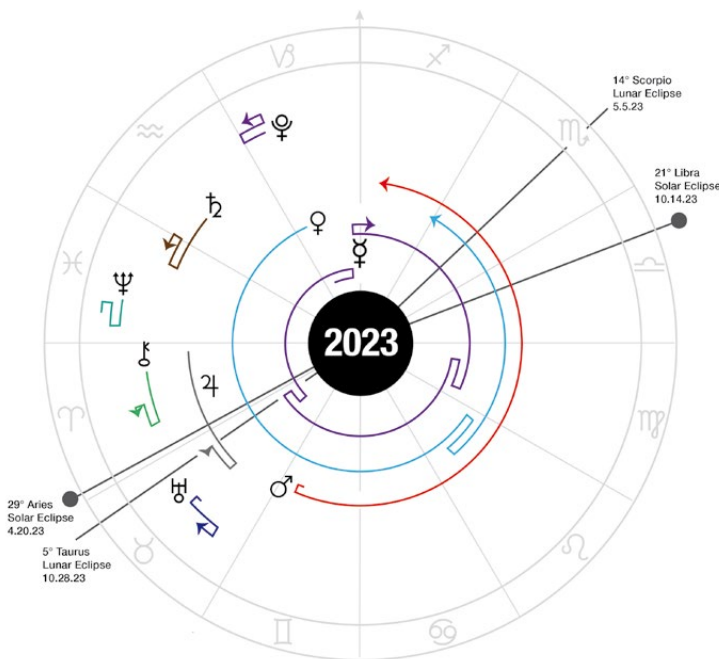


Chart 1 - 2023 Planetary Motions

The Pluto-Neptune Cycle

As big as the Pluto Cycle is, it sits inside an even larger one of the great conjunction between Pluto and Neptune. Our current 492-year Pluto/Neptune cycle began with a conjunction at (8° Gemini 36') on 01 August 1891 (see chart 2). The position of transiting Pluto at (27° Capricorn) is square natal Uranus at (27° Libra 36') in this chart (see chart 2), meaning present events are related to the cycle that began in 1891. These current times may call for a new level of technological discovery and innovation, possibly to spring-board from the early inventions of Nikola Tesla, who patented the Tesla Coil in 1891.

The US Pluto Return

We start 2023 in the throes of the US Pluto Return¹, which has been playing out throughout 2022, with three transiting Pluto conjunctions to the natal Pluto placement in the US Chart at 27° Capricorn 32'. These three conjunctions occurred 1) February 19, 2) July 11 (Rx), and 3) December 27, 2022 (see chart 3). Pluto will dive one last time into 27° Capricorn in September through October of 2023; however, it will not be perfect at 27°32'. As transiting Pluto completes its return in the US natal chart, the security of material wealth in capitalism, leadership in democratic principles, and allegiance to the standards of Lady Liberty will likely pass away.

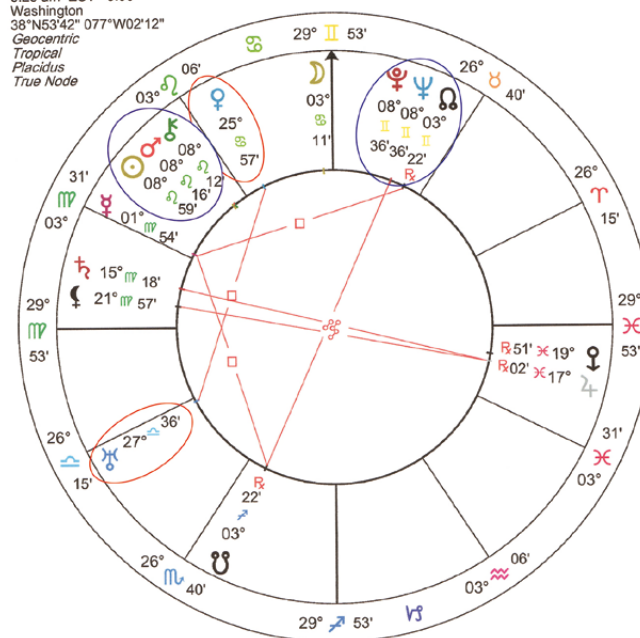


Chart 2 - Pluto/Neptune Conjunction

The values of the US people, as well as the world, have changed. With Pluto, first comes death, then rebirth.

Transformation of Power, Privilege, and Control

The past three years have brought the world to its knees individually, nationally, and globally. Pluto in Capricorn has been extreme for the US for the natal placement, and the power source of the country's chart is about to be 'reset' throughout 2023-2024. This brings the elimination of 'outdated' values of the country, with a 'new' ideology to develop in its place. Pluto does not signify a death in a literal sense but rather a metaphorical death, something ceasing to be.²

Since 2008, when Pluto entered Capricorn, we all have been learning how to own our authority and control our power consciously in the outer world³. We are in the final stages of letting go of 'old authority and control patterns' as Pluto prepares to leave the sign.

However, in 2023, the final year of Pluto in Capricorn, we realize that the 'reality' that we used to live in – **no longer exists**. And the new reality **does not make sense**, for the structures we built in the past were not designed for this new reality.

Pluto in Aquarius - Great Social Change

Pluto will dip its toe into Aquarius for a brief three-month stint March 23 - June 11, 2023, at 0° Aquarius. Pluto will be stationed at 0° Aquarius for three months, so it will fuel the powerful Jupiter/Saturn conjunction point, which was at 0° Aquarius on December 21, 2020.

"What holds power in the world" will change, from the physical systems of operation creating structure and order in the material world to mass reforms in the collective understanding of 'who we are,' creating a renaissance in the human mind. Communication, space innovation, technology, and socialization will be part of the mix.

People, events, or circumstances that 'arrive' in January through March of 2023 will likely become catalysts for our evolution, compelling us onto a new life direction ahead.

With Pluto in Aquarius, we begin to feel "different" and long for a new, more harmonic tribe. Worldly events, new relations, or crises may incite an inner urge to rebel against old systems, making us step up, express, and live by, unconventional ideas.

This 3-month period will test the waters by promoting a new understanding of the future. It may be time to adopt more socially meaningful programs to educate, benefit, reform, and tolerate *all*, not only a few.

Time to Honor, Celebrate, and Release the Past

As Pluto enters back into Capricorn, from June 11, 2023, to January 21, 2024, the final seven months of the year may signal a period of mourning. Personally, socially, politically, and economically, we may likely begin to release an established way of life we once knew... to allow the evolution of freedoms to actualize in our lives. 2023 marks the beginning of a full-scale psychological reconstruction and radical transformation in the Aquarius house(s) in your chart.

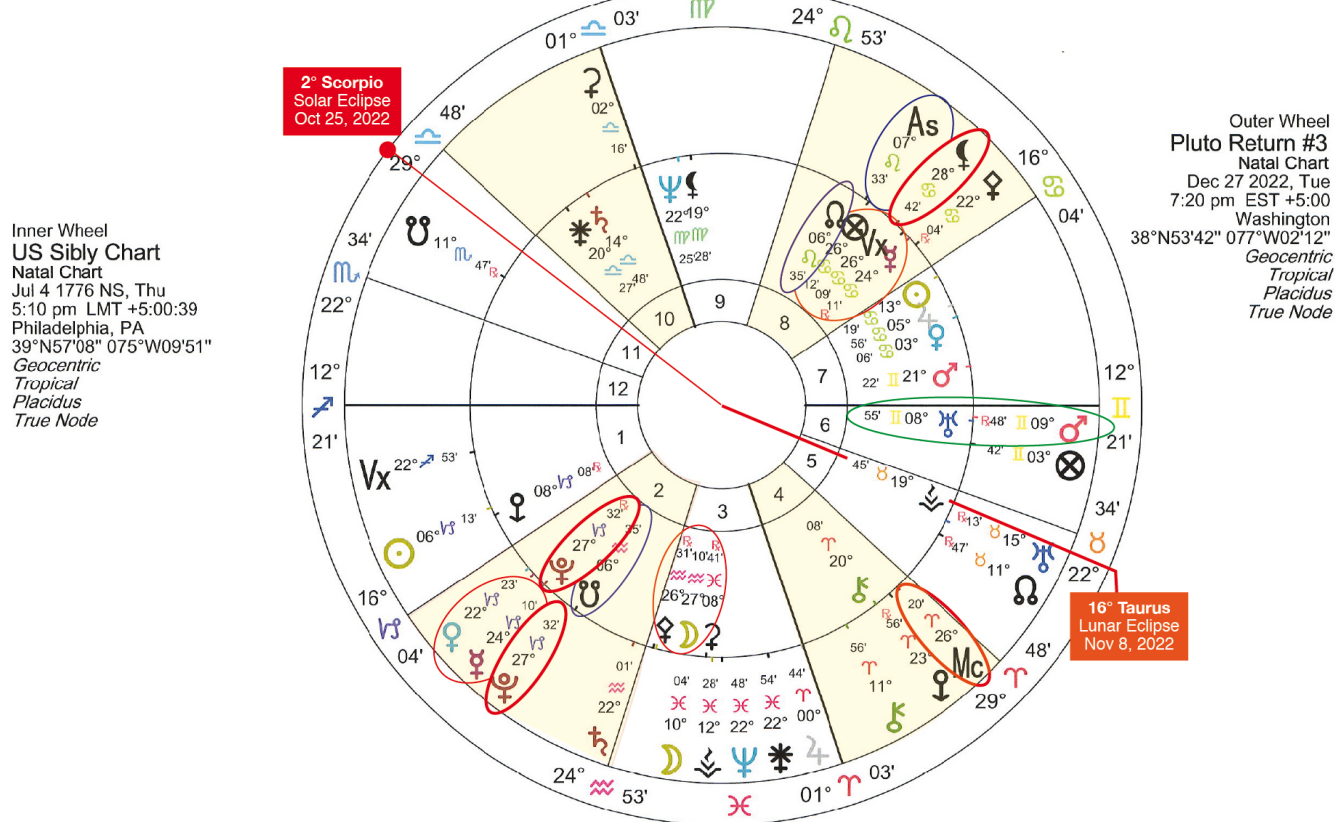

Ultimately Pluto will transit through the sign of Aquarius over the next 21 years, from January 21, 2024, through January 2044. The alchemy of healing begins when we realize it is our psychological rebirth, not death.

Saturn enters Pisces to give us the discipline to rebuild and restore our faith and yield a new vision for the dawning of a new day.

Saturn in Pisces – Cutting Our Losses

As Saturn has been in Aquarius from March 23, 2020, to March 7, 2023, we had three years of enduring lessons in dealing with the collective responsibility of self-control and integrating our individual authority within a group expression.

Our freedoms have been restricted as societal team efforts attempted to overcome the COVID-19 pandemic. Saturn in Aquarius required adjustments to work with others, making responsible reforms and being unable to 'do as we like.' It has required stamina, discipline, and patience to function within society's rules while navigating through fear, sadness, and the loss of loved ones.

On the other hand, we have seen technical revolutions in collaborative business, global communications, quantum computing, artificial intelligence, automation, and medical advances in immune technology.

As Saturn enters Pisces on March 7, 2023, it joins Neptune in the sign of 'sensitivity.' The Pisces house(s) in your chart will indicate where you will be tested. Previous systems and friendships may pass away as they no longer work. Acceptance, understanding, compassion, sacrifice, humility, and gratitude are essential; you can clear away old ambitions to make a fresh start.

Meditation, prayer, and emotional unity with others will work well now. Imagination coupled with mastery over universal laws may create self-healing, psychic surveillance and telepathy, miracles, and global peace on the physical plane.

Shadow work involving intuition, kundalini, drugs, or psychedelics may surface. A heightened period of artistry with music, dance, and film productions may inspire the masses or provide relief in dealing with fears of the unknown.

Eclipses – Residual Effects

The after-effects of the 2022 Fall Eclipses will continue to play out in 2023. Individuals with planets at the degrees of 2° and 16° in fixed signs will be carrying the torch for **"Being Forceful and Taking Power"** throughout the next six months and beyond, as these key degrees get activated by transits.

The Oct 25th, 2022, Solar Eclipse (2° Scorpio) brought in a new life being created as an opportunity to dust off the cobwebs and activate a part of ourselves that has been buried. A new love, money, possession, project, or business may have been kick-started. This is a powerful challenge to change us at the core of our being to create a 'new life.' It can provide a wake-up call with an opportunity for self-empowerment and much hard work!

This solar eclipse will play out through March 2023, and those with key placements at 2° in fixed signs should see the fruits of their labor manifest and move forward (Mar 26-Apr 3) with recognition by (May 25-30, 2023). A push to break through blocks will follow (Sept 8-22) and finally aid the affected parties in initiating a new self-image (Oct 16). This will be followed by announcing a 'new life undertaking' by the end of 2023 (Dec 17-29).

The November 8th, 2022, Lunar Eclipse (16° Taurus) likely brought a surprise or an awareness of a psychological change in relationships. Again, this is a wake-up call to how others may value you—or not—involving money or loyalty to a partnership. It may have brought in a new partner, who unveils the need to collaborate to move forward. Alternatively, it might reveal the need to go back and reframe past methods and choices, so a new story can be rewritten in our striving to develop personal power or professional ambition.

Uranus played a vital role in this November 2022 eclipse, as it conjoined the Full Moon on November 8, 2022 (16° Taurus 56') in retrograde motion and opposed to Mercury and the Sun (15° Scorpio 52' / 16° Scorpio 00'). **The logic resulting from Mars retrograde in Gemini was rewritten. The final strategy is ready to be launched by March 15 - April 4, 2023**, as transiting, direct Uranus reactivates the sensitive 16° Taurus point, awakening this Lunar Eclipse to its full potential and revolutionizing contracts and leadership in the world.

This is the time to act and reorient your personal life. We may unexpectedly deal with explosive situations due to new relations formed, or endings in partnerships due to disagreements and the inability to compromise.

Increasing the expression of this Lunar Eclipse, Vesta, Mercury, and Venus will all aspect and trigger this 16° sensitive point sequentially from **March 24-31, 2023**. Unexpected pledges of love or allegiance may support the 'fulfillment of one's heart's desires' for a new future now, which may catapult one into a new lifestyle, helping to release 'spells of the past.'

Mars – Rewriting the Strategy and Creating a New Story

Mars has been retrograde since October 30, 2022 (25° Gemini 36' 9:26 am EDT) and will turn direct on Jan 12, 2023 (8° Gemini 8'). Finally, we can confidently move forward on our 'revised' game plans. Mars remains out of bounds for 6.4 months, from Oct 23, 2022, until May 5, 2023 (25° Gemini - 21° Cancer), encouraging extreme behaviors around the world that may involve heated communications, intense news, anxiety, anger, fear, and violent events. Mars out of bounds may also bring abnormal or destructive weather conditions and natural disasters.



Mars aspects the degree of the November 2022 Lunar Eclipse (16° Taurus 00') in direct motion Feb 21-23, 2023. This will likely unleash the announcement of a new union, the breakdown of past alliances, or a change in allegiance. It may bring surprise propositions or unexpected, explosive threats.

Jupiter in Aries – Pioneering Self-expression

We start the year 2023 with Jupiter in the fire sign of Aries, Dec 20, 2022, to May 16, 2023. This sets the year's tone to start with a new drive to expand our world, set new goals, and pioneer passionate beliefs to obtain freedom and independence.

Traveling to far horizons for mere desire or adventure feels good now. Athletic activities and competitive inspirations arise with an optimistic willingness. Jupiter in Aries can boost our confidence to meet challenges head-on and enrich life through creative self-expression. It can also augur war, willful determinism, or the dispensation of law for justice. It is up to us to rise above harmful urges.

Jupiter in Taurus – The Rich Comforts of Life

Jupiter joins Uranus in the earth sign of Taurus from May 16, 2023, to May 25, 2024. This will initiate great enthusiasm to achieve or maintain goals to experience life's rich rewards. Typical manifestations of wealth, material success, and clever investing will be appreciated, as well as sensual love, fertility, romantic pleasures, and lavish spending on luxuries that stir the senses and feed the soul (see chart 4).

Jupiter in Taurus brings great optimism and confidence that things will work out as great changes and significant marks of accomplishment are reached.

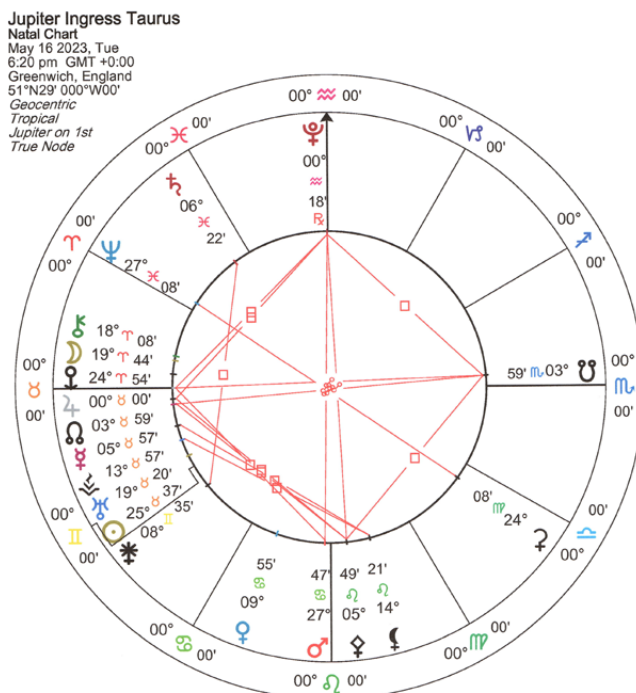


Chart 4 - Jupiter Enters Taurus - May 16, 2023

Jupiter in Taurus brings great optimism and confidence that things will work out as great changes and significant marks of accomplishment are reached.

However, upon ingress, Jupiter will be in a grand square with Pluto and the Moon's Nodes while applying to a conjunction with Mars. With Jupiter afflicted, this sets a powerful tone for an intense drive 'to succeed' vs. 'to dominate' and to hold onto acquired wealth and 'fixed' ideas that have manifested success. Our wealth, self-worth, self-love, and defining what is valued will be the focus of the second half of 2023.

Best Energy of the Year 2023

The period of Jan 22nd to April 21st brings **fruitful abundance**. All the planets will be moving forward now, so you have three strong months to launch your creative ideas into action! On January 21, the New Moon in Aquarius (1° 32') will conjoin Pluto within a 3° orb (28° Capricorn 20'), sending a wake-up call to empower us. Take advantage of this time to initiate reforms in career and public standing and take strides to 'make the mark.' It is also a time to complete past contracts and let go or transform relationships. Challenges with teams may be in store; however, it may be best to hold your own by breaking out new talents and building up self-sustainability.

Earth Mercury Year – Tighten the Purse Strings

Throughout 2023, Mercury will retrograde four times in EARTH signs: Capricorn – Taurus – Virgo – Capricorn. Thus, the year's primary focus will be on the material substance principle. An overall mindset, pausing for cautious reflection, will be to make practical spending decisions and limit operations to available resources.

During these retrogrades, we can anticipate the following

- Frugal spending, restrictions on travel, and a more conservative curriculum
- Potential cutbacks, shortages, or delays in trade/commerce and transportation of material goods
- A focus on physical supplies for basic survival needs
- A concentration on reliable productivity, tangible currency, and useful goods and services;
- People are looking for trustworthy advice.

Moon's Nodes – Transition into Aries/Libra

For the next 18 months, the Moon's Nodes will teach us lessons in self-actualization as they transit into Aries/Libra from July 17, 2023, to January 12, 2025.

Our focus dramatically changes on July 17, 2023, with the awareness that we may have relied too heavily on other people's opinions, partnerships, commitment, and support to move forward. Over the next 18 months, we will learn how to balance our reliance upon others with listening to our inner drive and building confidence to get the job done on our own. Self-reliance and self-assertion are essential.

We will likely discover that to create happiness and open new doors, we must independently promote ourselves. We will no longer operate as—or be known as—an extension of others.

2023 Spring Eclipses: Emotional Instincts Rather than Sound Judgment

The April 20th Solar Eclipse (29° Aries 50') initiates a dramatic push forward as an approaching Jupiter, and an out-of-sign square to Pluto expands and intensifies its energy (see chart 5).

It will test how well we have learned to act on or release the emotional baggage within ourselves or our family. 29° is a sensitive 'crisis-oriented' degree and marks the approaching end of a cycle.

This eclipse may stir those with tight aspects to it to be emotionally led by pent-up sexual or procreative drives, uncovering deep, hidden passions⁴. The desire to plunge into a new environment will be strong, and many may leave or separate from their tribe.

It will drive us to take courageous acts to pioneer independence; fulfill the desires of our hearts; express a hidden voice; and prepare the home and family to accept our conscious choices.

The May 5th Lunar Eclipse (14° Scorpio 58') will bring powerful fulfillment or cold opposition from others whom our abrupt change in character may mystify. We may have a knack for social interactions; however, a good deal is hidden behind the scenes.

Now that the situation has been 'exposed,' anticipate probing from others who want to understand the strategy, depth, history, and worth of a potential offer. Changed perspectives for one's future and information shared with others may create great inner emotional turmoil.

2023 Fall Eclipses: Mastery of Self-love

The Oct 14th Solar Eclipse (21° Libra 07') will test how fair we are to ourselves as we try to please others. It will bring a hard look at our soul's mission and purpose for being here. Self-love and taking action to maintain harmony, despite others' projected anger or retaliation, is the key.

Mastering peace *within* will allow mastering peace in the world. Undermining the core that fuels inspiration will lead to the atrophy of our souls. It's time to put our oxygen masks on first before saving others.

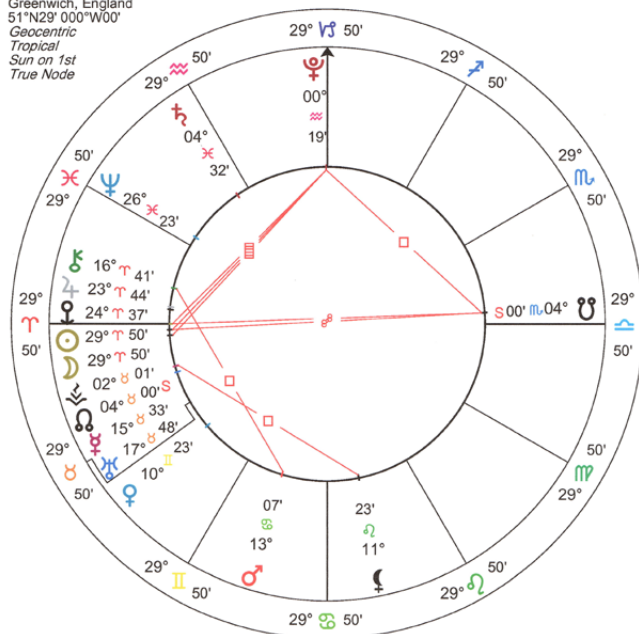


Chart 5 - April 20, 2023 Solar Eclipse

The Oct 28 Lunar Eclipse (5° Taurus 09') will offer an understanding of the **true value of life** and 'how' or 'how not' to acquire desired and valued resources. We may see significant changes in relations with friends, teams, business colleagues, or society at large, as they either 'stubbornly pull back,' reconsider our strategy, or remain loyal and align with our chosen direction.

Many may feel lost or abandoned by loved ones. The strength is in the personal *will* to live and thrive: to pull up our bootstraps, change our attitude, and reorient our lifestyle to do what is best to strengthen 'peace.'

Venus Retrogrades in Leo – Ruffled Feathers

Venus Retrogrades in Leo from July 22 to Sept 3 (28° - 12° Leo). This is a tough transit that starts with sextile/semi-sextile aspects between Venus and a partile cardinal grand square formed by the Sun in opposition to Pluto and squaring the Moon's nodes in the anaretic 29°. It will be a dramatic time to re-evaluate relations



and promises to others made instead of voicing our authentic leadership. **Fated choices** may be on the table, and heated flareups likely in store from our feelings that were not recognized, listened to, or given credence for their honor, worth, or loyalty.

This is the beginning of a psychological end to being a slave to the emotional obligations held to others. In the future, loyalty will need to acknowledge or stimulate our soul mission and provide a means for sustainability to ensure continued alignment with our valued work. We will no longer be able to tolerate the demands, distractions, or lifestyle strain that we have allowed to interfere with it.

Conclusion: Walking Through the Veil of Great Change

As we enter 2023, the state of global affairs is facing crisis on an international scale. Escalating global challenges may bring a year of great accountability for the world to uphold progressive leadership with a global commitment.

In 2023 the outer planets are not 'seeing' or interacting with each other, but ALL ARE CHANGING SIGNS (except Neptune and Uranus). This dramatic change of the guard in the heavens will be experienced throughout this year. We will deal with new circumstances and perspectives in life.

By the end of 2023, the focus will not likely rely upon working within partnerships but for each person to be independently guided on operating and adjusting their lifestyle as great changes occur. We will have the chance to 'consciously create a new reality

— in line with our soul mission,' the fruitfulness of the Earth and all upon it.

Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto DO NOT have any partile aspects with outer planets except Jupiter. Society at large IS NOT the focus this year. This will be a year of personal integration, acceptance of a new world, and changing our lives to adjust WITHIN IT.
